

"Holy & Whole"



Throughout the rest of March, we will be fasting for community wholeness with the goal to restore Mental Health Services to the Logan Square, Avondale and Hermosa neighborhoods. Some have decided to give up **"words that kill"** for Lent in order to speak words that give life.

We are also offering weekly **"Wellness Checks"** where we will meditate on God's word and allow the Spirit to heal our own wounds. The group meets on Wednesday evenings at 7 pm, at 3413 W. Medill Ave.

Finally, we will join other Logan Square churches and community organizations to help restore a public Community Mental Health Center for our community. Since 2009, the City of Chicago has steadily closed all but 6 of 19 local centers, including the one serving the northwest side in 2012. You'll hear more about this initiative at **Occupy Palm Sunday** at the Logan Square Eagle monument on March 25, following our worship service. We will **"Open the Gates to Wellness"** together.
