Fasting for Housing Justice

Throughout the month of March, we are using our Lenten Fast to support the Bring Chicago Home referendum that will create an designated funding stream to build more affordable housing for people experiencing homelessness. Join us for special events leading up to the election.

On Sunday, March 3, Vincente Hernandez and Mary Tarullo from the Chicago Coalition for the Homeless will be speaking at our worship service at 10:30 am. Vincente will share his story of being unhoused and Mary will explain how the Bring Chicago Home referendum offers hope for change.



Early voting begins on Monday, March 4, in each Ward of the city. To find the closest polling place, go to the <u>Chicago Board of Elections website</u>. The Primary Election ends on Tuesday, March 19. Vote Yes on Question #1 to pass the Bring Chicago Home referendum.

On Saturday, March 9, we will join Palenque LSNA and the congregations of the Logan Square Ecumenical Alliance (LSEA) for a "Get-Out-the-Vote" rally at the Logan Square Monument. The rally starts at 10:00 am. At 11:00 am, we will canvass with the 35th Ward.

For those who are available on **Saturday, March 16**, we will continue our **canvassing with the 35th Ward**.

The LSEA's Occupy Palm Sunday on March 24, will focus on the results of the Bring Chicago Home referendum.

We will join the LSEA congregations for a **combined worship service at Humboldt Park UMC**, 2120 N. Mozart, starting at 10:30 am, followed by a rally at the Logan Square Monument at 12:30 pm. For those who cannot attend in person, there will be a hybrid option for the worship service.
